To deliver a traffic calming scheme as part of the highways & technical 4-year framework for Salford City Council, that would effectively reduce vehicle speeds along The Quays while ensuring minimal disruption to local businesses and residents. This involved the installation of speed cushions and traffic islands to improve road safety in a high-traffic area.



OUR Challenges

The key challenge was the location of the project, which involved one of the main access points to Salford Quays, a busy area with high traffic volumes. Additionally, maintaining access for businesses and residents while conducting the works required careful planning and phased execution.
